

## Homeschool Tracker Plus Version 6.0 Release 1 Release Date – April 3, 2009

This list provides a *brief description* of the new features in **Homeschool Tracker Plus Version 6.0 Release 1**. For additional details about any of these features, please refer to the Help File (F1) or User Manual.

### ***New Features***

#### • **General**

- Changed menu bar options to: File; New; Tools; Database; Help
  - **File** menu: provides quick access to creating a new database or opening an existing database; also provides a list of the most recently used database files making it easier to switch back and forth as needed.
  - **New** menu: provides access to “add new” forms for Assignment; Appointment/Chore; Field Trip; Holiday/Vacation; Lesson Plan item; Memorization task; Reading Log; and Resource
  - **Tools** menu: access to the various tools and options in the program
  - **Database** menu: continues to provide a means of creating a new database and/or pointing to an existing file; Backup procedures also continue to be run from this menu
  - **Help** menu: access to help file; getting started info; etc.
- Changed the panel calendars in the Student: Assignments; Student: Journal; and Teacher: Journal to a neutral background so as to no longer clash with selected theme colors.
- **Sorting** – your sorting settings are maintained on program close. Any grid that retains grouping will now also retain sorting.

#### • **Agenda**

- **School Days** – new option in View drop down list. When selected, it will show only the actual school days for the date/week selected in the calendar. Only available for one week view at a time.
- **List** – new option in View drop down list. This view provides greater access to all items, including appointments and chores, which are spread over a range of dates making it easier to delete such items. All types of Agenda items for one or multiple students can be viewed in this format.
  - Group Edit is not available in this view
  - You can group and sort the list view to meet your needs.
  - You can view any date; range of dates; or the entire school year.
- **Multi-Student View** – side by side calendars for selected students.
  - If the main Student drop down is set to All Students, you will see all students for the date(s) selected
  - If the main Student drop down is set to one student, you will see just that student
  - In either case, you can check the “View Multiple Students” option on the Agenda control panel to view any one, two or more students side by side.
  - Only operational in Day; School Days; and Week views.
- Added an option for a notation for **Journal** entries on the Student: Agenda. When selected, the Title of your Journal entry will appear in the top section of the display on the date of the entry. Double-clicking on the Title will allow you to edit the Journal item.

#### • **Appointments**

- Using the Agenda: List View, Appointments are now more easily removed if an error has been made in their creation.

- **Assignments**
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Assignments – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments from created assignments when using the Copy or Use as New feature.
  - **Copy Features** – added an option for a 3-level copy increment. So now you can increment in the following ways: Chapter 1, Chapter 2, Chapter 3; or Lesson 1-A; Lesson 1-B; Lesson 2-A; Lesson 2-B; or Chapter 1: Lesson1: Section A; Chapter 1: Lesson 1: Section B; etc.
    - New **“Spread evenly”** feature that allows you to spread the created assignments over the valid school days within a specified date range.
  - **Copy to Lesson Plan** – when you copy assignments into a Lesson Plan, Tracker will now automatically assign sequence numbers based on the Date Due of those items. Previously, all sequence numbers were set to zero.
    - Sequence numbers will be assigned beginning with 10,000 (ten thousand) so as not to interfere with existing plan items
    - Items will be given sequence numbers in order based on the original Date Due of the assignments. Gaps between date due values are ignored
    - All items with the same original date due will be given the same sequence number
    - You can use the right-click Lesson Plan menu option to “Change Selected Sequence numbers” to adjust the auto-generated sequence numbers to suit your needs.
  - **Reschedule** – right-click Reschedule has a new option to “Make it Fit” so that you can move items in the assignment grid and have them all placed on dates on or before an ending date you specify.
  - **Search** – you can now search among your assignments within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against Subject; Course; Activity; Resource; Page/Lesson/Chapter; Topic; Directions and Notes fields.
    - Hidden fields will be included in the search parameters.
    - This search field is tied to the search fields in the other Student tab areas: Field Trip; Goals Progress; Memorization; and Reading Log.
  - **Supplies** – you can create lists of supplies needed for your assignment. Can be printed in separate report.
  - **Timer** – new right-click option for any one or more assignments
    - Count up or down for any assignment
    - Initiate via right-click menu or Tools menu or F4 key
    - More than one timer can be active at one time
    - Elapsed time can be copied into the Time Spent field of selected assignments; time will be rounded to nearest minute
    - Elapsed time can be copied to the clipboard and pasted wherever you choose; this will be the exact time elapsed – including seconds
    - You can choose a sound wave to play when countdown is complete
- **Attendance**
  - **All Students View** – will now show attendance for all students in the “All Students” view of the attendance calendar. Will utilize the new 3-character “Initials” field in the Student record.
  - **View Assignments** – right-clicking on any date will bring up the View Assignments option. Click the option to see the assignments for that date.

- **Backups**
  - Tracker will now check the destination folder before beginning backup to insure there is enough room to copy the file. If not, a message will appear, rather than a program-closing error.
- **Chores**
  - Using the Agenda: List View, Chores are now more easily removed if an error has been made in their creation.
- **Courses**
  - Replaced the "None" course with blank text – so you don't have the word "None" showing everywhere.
  - Courses are automatically enabled, making the Transcript enabled as well. You can choose to hide the Course from grid display as usual, if you like.
  - As with the previous "None" course, when the Course field is blank, the Default Grading scale is in effect for those assignments; weighted grading is not available for those items; and no credit hours will be awarded on the Transcript for those items. You must select a Course from your list in order to take advantage of those features.
- **Database**
  - Created a "Recent Databases" list under the File menu to make it easier to locate the last file used for those who switch between database files.
- **Field Trips**
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Field Trips – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments from created field trips when using the Use as New feature.
  - **Search** – you can now search among your Field Trips within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against Description; Subject; Course; Topic; and Notes fields.
    - Hidden fields will be included in the search parameters.
    - This search field is tied to the search fields in the other Student tab areas: Assignments; Goals Progress; Memorization; and Reading Log.
- **Goals**
  - **Student: Goals Progress**
    - New tab under the Student tab area
    - Keep track of what goals your student is working on.
    - Goals can be listed as "In Progress" or "Complete"
    - Goals are listed when they are attached to an assignment, field trip, memorization or reading log item that falls within the Active School Year.
    - Right-click menu has "View" options so you can see which Assignments/Field Trips; Memorization; and/or Reading Lot items contain the selected goal.
    - You can group/sort the Goals Progress grid to meet your needs.
    - If you are using Student Colors, they will show in this grid
    - You can add notes to a goal for a student to chart progress
    - Student goals can be printed in a report for "In Progress"; "Complete"; or both, with or without the Notes field.
  - **Teacher: Goals**
    - Items in the Teacher: Goals list can now be archived from view
    - You can group/sort the Teacher: Goals grid
    - The details of a goal can be as long as you wish. There is no longer a limit to the number of characters.

- **Import/Export** – you can import or export lists of Teacher: Goals created in Homeschool Tracker Plus.
- **Search** – you can now search among your Goals
  - Search text will compare against Set; Discipline; and Goal fields.
  - Not tied to Search fields in other Teacher or Student tab areas.
- **Grading**
  - Grading Scales moved to Maintenance: Other area so that we could expand functionality
  - Access Grading Scales by going to Maintenance: Other tab; then choose Grading Scales from the drop down list.
  - Set minimum passing percentage for Pass/Fail courses
  - Choose letter/symbol for failing grades; defaults to "F"
  - Existing grading scales updated to new format
  - Archive; Reclassify; and/or Delete Grading scales. Note: deleting a grading scale that has previously been used will require assigning a different grading scale to that course and previous grades will now reflect the new scale.
  - Create as many or as few grades per scale as you like – choose to create +/- grades or not as you desire. No need to have extra lines showing in grading scales for values you aren't using.
  - Create as many different grading scales as you like
  - Use the Copy feature to quickly duplicate a grading scale and then make changes to it.
- **Import/Export**
  - It's not just for Lesson Plans anymore
  - You can now import/export Lesson Plans; Library items; Goals and/or Holidays
- **Journal**
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Journal entries for both Student and Teacher journal items.
  - **Student Journal** – added an item to the Agenda display list to show that there is a journal entry for the student on that date. Display will show Journal entry title and category.
- **Lesson Plan**
  - **# of Days** – you can now choose to have Tracker base the next Date Given/Date Due on the number of days of the last Lesson Plan item booked (when submitting at the same time). This means if you have an item with a # of Days greater than 1, the next item will not be assigned until the day after the last item was due.
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Lesson Plan items – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments in created assignments when using the Submit feature
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments in lesson plan items created using the Copy or Use as new features.
  - **Change Sequence Numbers** – For all options in this menu, you can now choose to effect only the selected items, or all items in the Lesson Plan with a sequence number that is equal to or higher than a single selected item.
    - Added an insert function in this menu to make it easier for you to create "space" (unused sequence numbers) so you can create intervening items into an existing Lesson Plan.
    - Added new "Make it Fit" choice to have Tracker automatically resequence your items to fit within a specified number of "days" in the Lesson Plan.
  - **Changed** name of field/column from GROUP to CUSTOM

- **Copy**
  - Added an option for a **3-level copy increment**. So now you can increment in the following ways:  
Chapter 1, Chapter 2, Chapter 3; or  
Lesson 1-A; Lesson 1-B; Lesson 2-A; Lesson 2-B; or  
Chapter 1: Lesson1: Section A; Chapter 1: Lesson 1: Section B; etc.
  - Added a **Preview** screen so you can review the items you've created using the Copy feature before committing them to your Lesson Plan. The preview will display the newly created items as well as the existing items in the plan (color-coded) in sequence number order so you can see the effect before adding the new items.
  - **Import** – added an option that allows you to preview the original lesson plan before importing it. In the preview window you can group the view any way you like. You can also use the OK box to uncheck the items you do not wish to import.
  - **Search** – you can now search among your Lesson Plan items in a selected plan within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against Subject; Course; Activity; Resource; Page/Lesson/Chapter; Topic; Directions; and Notes fields.
    - Not tied to Search fields in other Teacher or Student tab areas.
  - **Submit**
    - New **"Spread evenly"** feature to place a specified selection of Lesson Plan items within a particular date range. Items will be spread evenly over the valid dates in the range. The overall order of your Lesson Plan items as indicated by sequence and order number will be maintained. Items with different sequence numbers may end up on the same date in order to spread the items evenly as indicated. The original Lesson Plan will not be adjusted in any way.
    - **Submit Starting Date** – If Today's date (your computer system date) is outside of the Active School Year, then the starting date for submitting will be the first date from the start of the active school year that meets your selection in Tools: Options: Assignments. For example – if your selection in Tools: Options: Assignments is to start the submit date on a Monday and today is 12/23/2008 (a Tuesday) and you're working with the 2009-2010 school year, then the Starting Date will default to the first Monday in your 2009-2010 school year, rather than today's date or next Monday's date – neither of which are within the school year you're working with.
  - **Supplies** – you can create lists of supplies needed for your assignment. Can be printed in separate report.
- **LP Schedules**
  - **Use as New** – added Use as New button to the top of the LP Schedule area. This will allow you to quickly duplicate the schedule you are currently viewing. You will need to select a schedule name. This can be helpful if you have two students with similar schedules. You can duplicate the first schedule, and then tweak the copy to meet the needs of Student #2.
- **Library**
  - A **new tab** under the Maintenance area.
  - The Library is a listing of all books/texts/resources that are used in the program. It can also contain items you hope to obtain/use at some future date.
  - Upon updating to Version 6.0, a library will be created from all the distinct items in your Maintenance: Resources list and Student: Reading Log entries. You may choose to use the Reclassify feature to consolidate duplicate items.

- The Library entry will contain all the specific information about the item: title; author; publisher; ISBN; borrowed and loaned information; etc.
- Included a "Custom" field so you can add your own additional grouping information.
- An image of the book cover can be included in the Library entry.
- For item entry via ISBN, Tracker will be utilizing the Amazon.com database instead of ISBNdb.com. You will not need an access key for this ISBN lookup process.
- The original NOTES field from Resources (Version 5.3 and previous) will be added to the Library item.
- The Resource Notes2 field (Version 5.3 and previous) will remain with the Resource record.
- You can export selected Library items to a file to share with other Homeschool Tracker Plus users. Likewise, you can import a file of Library items from other users.
- You can select specific Library items to be included in a report – like the "send to report" option in the Assignments grid.
- **Maintenance**
  - **Added** Library tab. See *Library* above.
  - **Moved** Grading Scales to this location, under the "Other" sub-tab. See *Grading* above.
- **Memorization**
  - **Goals** – you can add goals to your Memorization items.
  - **Search** – You can now search among your Memorization tasks within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against List Type; Title; and Notes fields.
    - Hidden fields will be included in the search parameters.
    - This search field is tied to the search fields in the other Student tab areas: Assignments; Field Trips; Goals Progress; and Reading Log
- **Overview**
  - Letter grade now appears in display between Avg (average) and WtdVal (weighted value) columns.
    - This letter grade represents the current overall grade for the subject/course based on the graded items to date.
    - If it is a weighted course, the letter grade reflects the total weighted grade to date.
    - In a Pass/Fail course, the appropriate word will be displayed.
- **Program Options**
  - Changed the format of the Tools: Options window (F3) to allow for more options.
  - **General options:**
    - Added an option to set the number of recent databases to remember. If you are using more than one database for any reason, **Homeschool Tracker Plus** can now assist you in keeping track of where those databases are located. Just like the "recently used" option in MS Word, the File menu of the program will show you the last 1-9 databases you have accessed.
    - Removed ISBN.com Access Key field as it is no longer necessary.
  - **Assignment options:**
    - Added an option to set your preference for the Assignment Calendar display as either Current Week or Current Day. If you choose Current Week, Sunday to Saturday of the current week will be displayed. If you choose Current day, only one date will be highlighted, based on your

computer system date. This setting only affects the date selection when you start the program each day. You can click on any date or range of dates as you like.

- Added an option to enable/disable the Attachment feature/field.
- Added an option to enable/disable the I'm Done field in the assignment add/edit window and assignment grid
- Added an option to enable/disable the Page/Lesson/Chapter field in the assignment add/edit window and assignment grid. If you disable this field, you have also disabled the feature to create assignments with auto-incremented page/lesson/chapter information in assignments; lesson plans; and/or weekly planner.
- Added an option to enable/disable the Supplies feature/field.
- **Notification** options:
  - Added a new option to allow you to turn off the notification of duplicate assignments when submitting from a Lesson Plan or Weekly Planner item. This is a separate option from the one that notifies you of duplicate assignment creation directly in the assignment grid. You can choose to enable both notifications; disable both; or have one enabled and the other disabled.
  - Changed the Notification of marking complete with zero grade reminder to give you the chance to enter a grade at that point without having to re-edit the assignment. This notification is only in effect (as always) for single item selection.
  - Added option to have pop-up appear each time you open the program notifying you of library items that are due to be returned.
- **Reading Log**
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to reading log items – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments from created reading log items when using the Use as New feature.
  - **Goals** – you can attach goals to Reading Log items.
  - **Grid Display** – Since the Library grid will hold on to the book's details; the Reading Log grid will now display simply student; title; goals; attachments; time spent/session totals; start/end dates; and notes. When editing an entry, you will be able to see all the particulars of the selected item (author; publisher; etc.) that you have entered and that information can be edited without leaving the Student: Reading Log screen.
  - **Search** – You can now search among your Reading Log items within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against Title and Notes fields.
    - Hidden fields will be included in the search parameters.
    - This search field is tied to the search fields in the other Student tab areas: Assignments; Field Trips; Goals Progress; and Memorization tasks.
- **Reports**
  - **General**: Changed Choose Font link to Other Options link where you can choose to use or suppress gray shading; choose fonts; and choose to include or exclude all or part of the footer details of date; page number and school name. Also added additional font selection for the motto/verse for those reports that include that item.
  - **General**: added two new ways to close the preview window – with the newly added Close button, or via the Esc key

- **Agenda:**
  - Added the option to choose fields to include/exclude in the report: Subject; Course; Activity; Resource; and/or Page/Lesson/Chapter
  - Added two new report styles for Weekly 1-page and Weekly 2-page
- **Assignment Calendar:**
  - The order of items within a particular subject/course are ordered by start time, then the order field, then alphabetically by Activity
- **Assignments:**
  - New options of which fields can be included/excluded in the report: Subject; Course; and Attachments were added to the existing options.
  - If Start/End times are enabled in Tools: Options, those settings will affect the order of items in the Assignments report even if you choose to suppress printing of the times themselves.
- **Attendance:**
  - Added option to include school name; address; phone number and/or motto/verse to this report.
- **Borrowed Items Due:**
  - New grouping options to group by date; borrowed from location; or no grouping, just a chronological list by date due to be returned.
- **Courses:**
  - When including Resources in the Expanded Courses report you can choose to include resources from completed assignments; all assignments; or all the Resources attached to that Course.
- **Daily Task List:**
  - Added option to exclude subject or course. Previously you could include both or neither; now you can choose to include or exclude just one or the other.
  - When Memorization items are included, they will be listed in alphabetical order by List type and then Title.
  - When using the 'Send to Report' option, you can now choose to include appointments; chores; memorization tasks and/or reading log items to your selected assignments.
- **Detail Progress:**
  - Formerly known as "Progress Report Details"
  - When including completed items, you can choose to include only those items with grades
  - You can choose whether to include the date and time fields
  - You can choose to group by Date and then Student; or by Student and then Date
- **Goals Progress:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Replaces the Goals Met report
  - Include goals that are 'In Progress' or 'Completed' or both
  - Include notes about the student's progress if desired
  - Include details of assignments; memorization; and/or reading log items that support the goal
- **Grading Scales:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Create a printout of any grading scale
- **Lesson Plan:**
  - New options of which field can be included/excluded in the report: Subject; Course; Activity; Resource; Page/Lesson/Chapter; Topic and Attachments were added to the existing options.

- **Lesson Plan Names:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Create a printout of Lesson Plan names
  - Include Active and/or Archived
  - Include just plan names or objectives and goals.
- **Library Items:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Create a list of items in the Library, grouped and sorted as you like.
  - Single column or full page-width option
- **Memorization:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Create a list of Memorization items – incomplete; completed; or both
- **Monthly Progress:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - A report for a calendar month showing daily Time Spent or Sessions; Attendance; and a raw grade for each subject/course per day in a grid format
  - Weighting is not taken into account in this report
  - You can choose to include/exclude Reading Log time
  - Includes option to roll up Courses into Subjects
- **Overview:**
  - Changed report options to allow selection of any date range for the report, instead of being restricted to only term by term reporting.
  - Added option to roll up Courses into Subjects.
- **Reading Log:**
  - Added an option for a full-page format, rather than the single column. The full page format uses less paper for the same amount of toner.
- **Reading Log Form:**
  - Added lines for ISBN and Time Spent
  - Single column or full page-width format
- **Reading Log Time Spent:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Print a report with the detail of the 'Add Time' feature of your Reading Log items
  - Group by date or by book title
- **Report Card:**
  - Added an option to include a Title of your choosing
  - Added an option to include Notes about your student's progress. Notes are entered in the Grade Level section of the Student record.
  - Grouping option to roll up Courses into Subjects.
- **Resources:**
  - Added an option for a full-page format, rather than the single column. The full page format uses less paper for the same amount of toner.
- **Resources by Student:**
  - Added an option for a full-page format, rather than the single column. The full page format uses less paper for the same amount of toner.
- **Supplies Shopping List:**
  - \*New Report\*
  - Print out a list of supplies needed
  - Choose to include supplies from Incomplete and/or Complete assignments; Weekly Planner items; and/or Lesson Plan items

- **Time Spent/Sessions:**
  - Added an option to run the report for incomplete assignments; completed assignments or both
  - When using the Home/Away format, you can now have each "Away" location listed with individual time spent/sessions for each
  - Grouping option to roll up Courses into Subjects.
- **Transcript – Columns**
  - If including Activities and Achievements, you can also choose to include any hours attributed to those items.
- **Transcript – Full Page**
  - If including Activities and Achievements, you can also choose to include any hours attributed to those items.
- **Reschedule**
  - **Make it Fit** - When using the Manual Reschedule option – either from Tools: Reschedule or by right-clicking over selected assignments in the Assignment grid – you now have a "Make it Fit" option. This allows you to condense those items to fit into a smaller time frame or stretch them out over a longer date range.
- **Resources**
  - Replaced the "None" Resource with blank text – so you don't have the word "None" showing everywhere.
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Resources – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments in resources created using the Use as new features.
  - **Grid Display** - Since the Library grid will hold on to the book's details; the Resource grid will now display simply Title; subject/course designations; attachments and notes. When editing an entry, you will be able to see all the particulars of the selected item (author; publisher; etc.) that you have entered, and that information can be edited without leaving the Maintenance: Resources screen.
  - **Search** – you can now search among your Resources
    - Search text will compare against Title and Notes fields.
    - Not tied to Search fields in other Teacher or Student tab areas.
- **Security**
  - Updated security features
    - Insured that all fields and buttons that should be disabled, are indeed disabled under student sign-in
    - Notes field of Assignments no longer visible to students signed in under Security at any level
    - Separated Date fields so that you can give permission to change any or none of the following: Date Given; Date Due; Date Complete
- **Students**
  - Added "**Initials**" field – where you can enter the student initials or any 1-3 alphanumeric characters you like. This will be used to display the student's attendance in the "All Students" view of the Attendance calendar. Upon update this field will be filled with the first three letters of the Student first name.
  - **Activities & Achievements** – added a feature that allows you to track the number of hours spent in any of the activities entered. The hours can be included in a Transcript and/or the Student Activities & Achievements report. Only hours/minutes can be entered – not Sessions. They are **not** added into

- Time Spent values. This is strictly a value-added feature for the Transcript and Activities & Achievements reports.
- **Grade Level** – Added an area to enter Notes that can be printed on the Report Card for that school year.
- **Subjects**
  - Added a new button to the Subjects/Courses grid called Change Order. In this window you can drag and drop subjects into the order you want. There is also an “Alpha” button which will return the subjects to a straight alphabetical order.
  - Move Up/Move Down buttons removed in favor of the better interface
- **Supplies**
  - Added a feature that allows you to create a Supplies list in any Lesson Plan item; Weekly Planner item or Assignment
  - Supply list entries will be carried over through the Lesson Plan Submit and Weekly Planner Prepare functions; as well as the Assignment Copy and Assignment Use as New functions.
  - Reporting: Generate a list of supplies needed for incomplete and/or complete assignments; weekly planner items; and/or lesson plans.
- **Used By/Reclassify**
  - **Deletion option** – when you check the Used By status of a Maintenance item (subject; course; activity; lesson plan name; resource; etc), Tracker will display the items in the database that are using the Maintenance item. We have added an option that will allow you delete those items (assignments, lesson plan items; weekly planner items; etc) from that window without having to leave the process to find and delete them in other areas of the program. Deleted items cannot be retrieved.
  - When using the Reclassify option, you will be presented with a scrollable list of options in that category, rather than simply a drop down list.
- **Weekly Planner**
  - **Attachments** – you can attach references to Weekly Planner items – either file paths or URLs.
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments in created assignments when using the Prepare feature
    - You can select to include or exclude attachments in Weekly Planner items created using the Copy or Use as new features.
  - **Copy Features** –
    - Added an option for a 3-level copy increment. So now you can increment in the following ways: Chapter 1, Chapter 2, Chapter 3; or Lesson 1-A; Lesson 1-B; Lesson 2-A; Lesson 2-B; or Chapter 1: Lesson1: Section A; Chapter 1: Lesson 1: Section B; etc.
    - Added an option for “Selected Days” (1 wk pattern) or “2wk” (2 week pattern) of assignment days. In the “Prepare” window you can choose whether to start with week 1 or week 2 of your 2wk patterns for the selected items.
  - **Search** – you can now search among your Weekly Planner items within the parameters of your drop down settings.
    - Search text will compare against Subject; Course; Activity; Resource; Page/Lesson/Chapter; Directions; and Notes fields.
    - Not tied to Search fields in other Teacher or Student tab areas.
  - **Supplies** – you can create lists of supplies needed for your assignment. Can be printed in separate report.

## **Fixes**

- **Agenda**
  - Fixed “click for more” arrow so that it now shows you the additional items. In Day; School Days; or Week view, it will auto-scroll the screen. In the Month view, it will switch you to the Day view to see the additional items.
- **General**
  - Fixed the error that can arise when you’re editing in the grid (especially check boxes) and click in just the wrong place. Now, even if the add/edit window opens; you’ll be able to continue your edit and save the record with no program-closing error.
- **Lesson Plans**
  - Fixed an issue where items copied from Assignment grid to lesson plan were erroneously being marked as copy-protected and therefore unable to export along with Lesson Plan
- **Reclassify**
  - Fixed an issue where reclassification of Courses was not changing the Subject field as well when required.
- **Reports**
  - **Daily Task List** –
    - You no longer need to select the “include non-school days” option to get Past Due assignments to appear on the report.
    - Under ‘Directions and Notes’, the ‘Repeat directions each day for identical items’ now properly applies to Long Term assignments as well as Chores and Memorization Tasks.
  - **Goals Met** – report generates properly from “send to report” option even when incomplete items are included in the selection.
  - **LP Schedule** – when the LP Schedule is empty, Tracker will no longer throw an error when you try to print the “Details” version of the report.
  - **Scope & Sequence** – fixed an issue with report page break on Subject; Course and resource when displaying the Resource. Also, if displaying Resources and the Resource is set to “None”, the report will show “No Resource Specified”.
